

## The College Radio Woodie

### Official Voting Rules

These are the official terms and conditions for voting for "The Woodies" ("Official Voting Rules"). These Official Voting Rules are incorporated by reference into [www.mtvu.com](http://www.mtvu.com)'s and [www.ratemyprofessors.com](http://www.ratemyprofessors.com)'s Terms of Use Agreements.

#### 1. ELIGIBILITY

At the time of voting, voter must be a legal U.S. resident and cannot be an employee, agent or representative of MTV Networks on Campus, a subsidiary of Viacom International Inc. ("MTVNOC"), Viacom Inc., or any of their respective parent companies, affiliate or related companies.

#### 2. HOW TO VOTE

Follow the instructions on [radiowoodie.ratemyprofessors.com](http://radiowoodie.ratemyprofessors.com) to find your college radio preference during the applicable voting period by clicking the button adjacent to or below the college radio's name, then follow the instructions to complete the voting process. Online entries may be subject to standard internet connection fees. A day is defined as 12:00:01 AM (ET) to 11:59:59 PM (ET) of the same day.

#### 3. VOTING PERIODS

(a) **PHASE 1 consists of 3 Rounds detailed below:**

**NOTE: Voting takes place on [radiowoodie.ratemyprofessors.com](http://radiowoodie.ratemyprofessors.com).**

**Round 1** – To select the Top 100 college radio stations: August 18, 2009 – September 8, 2009

**Round 2** – To select the Top 50 college radio stations: September 8, 2009 – September 15, 2009

**Round 3** – To select the Top 25 college radio stations: September 15, 2009 – September 29, 2009

(b) **PHASE 2 consists of 2 Rounds detailed below:**

**NOTE: Voting for Round 2 of Phase 2 takes place on [radiowoodie.ratemyprofessors.com](http://radiowoodie.ratemyprofessors.com) AND [woodies.mtv.com](http://woodies.mtv.com).**

**Round 1** – To select Nominees: September 29, 2009 and ends October 26, 2009

**Round 2** – To select Winner: October 26, 2009 – November 9, 2009

Winner to be announced at The Woodies on November 18, 2009 on or around 11:00:01 PM (ET)

Use of any device to automate a vote is prohibited, including, but not limited to, software-generated, robotic, programmed, script, macro or other automated votes. MTVNOC reserves the right at its sole discretion to disqualify any individual they suspect or find: (i) to have used a software-generated, robotic, programmed, script, macro or other automated online or text message entry; (ii) to have tampered with the voting process; (iii) to be acting in violation of these Voting Rules; or (iv) to be acting in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner, or with intent to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass any other person.

The total number of votes submitted for each entrant will be tabulated by MTVNOC. All votes submitted become the sole property of MTVNOC and will not be acknowledged or returned.

If, for any reason, any aspect of this voting process is not capable of running as planned, including infection by computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical or system failures or disruption, 'Acts of God' or terrorist attacks, or any other causes beyond the control of MTVNOC which corrupt or affect the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of the voting process or for any reason MTVNOC deems necessary, MTVNOC reserves the right at its sole discretion to cancel, terminate, modify or suspend the voting process and reserves the right in its sole discretion to determine the winner.
